What is NCYC?

In a distinctly Catholic setting, the National Catholic Youth Conference invites participants to encounter Christ, experience church, and be empowered for discipleship.

NCYC is an exciting 3 day event held every 2 years, referred to as the “Superbowl for Catholic Teens.” The experience allows both youth and adult chaperones to be empowered and grow deeper in their faith and relationship with Christ the prayer, worship, adoration, liturgy, reconciliation , keynote talks and workshops, recreation, and special activities in a communal environment. Over 20,000 Catholic youth are expected at the Conference this year. NCYC is open to high school age young people and their chaperones. Many of the teens are leaders in their parishes, schools and/or dioceses. For many it is the first time they have attended an event of this magnitude to connect them with the greater Catholic Church.
